## Yorkshire Squash League Rules

A full list of the league rules are available on <u>www.yorkshiresquash.com</u>. Some key points are given below.

- Each team will play in order of merit, as set out in the squad list submitted at the start of the season.
- Match results shall be submitted by the home team via the web site within 72 hours of the games being completed. Clubs will be penalised five points for failing to comply with this limit.
- Players can only substitute in a higher team for a total of five times during the season.
- In every match, each team must have a minimum of two players who are eligible to play for Yorkshire in the Inter-County Championships or reside in Yorkshire.
- Players must have played a game before the Christmas break to be eligible to play for the rest of the season (unless there are exceptional circumstances, and with permission of the League Secretary).
- Matches should not be rearranged unless it is unavoidable, and clubs are not obliged to accept requests to rearrange. Where a club fails to honour a fixture, it shall be penalised 20 points and the offended club shall be awarded 20 points.
